**Subj: CAPTAIN OF THE PORT HOUSTON-GALVESTON APPROVED WASTE RECEPTION FACILITIES**

The International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL 73/78) calls for lessening the amounts of pollution by oily wastes, Noxious Liquid Substances (NLS) and garbage. The United States is a party to MARPOL and outlines the provisions for the proper disposal of wastes from ocean going ships. These provisions are captured in Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 158.

Thru the requirements of 33 CFR Part 158, a Certificate of Adequacy is issued after a regulated facility demonstrates to the Captain of the Port an ability to receive oil, NLS, and/or garbage wastes from ocean-going vessels. Seventy facilities throughout the port of Houston have completed the Certificate of Adequacy process, meet federal waste-reception standards, and are capable of receiving wastes. A list of the points of contact at these waste reception facilities is provided for your assistance. I have also enclosed three other helpful references dealing with waste reception.

The Coast Guard is intent to work through the Chemical Transportation Advisory Committee to optimize the use of domestic MARPOL port reception facilities. I encourage you, as vessel representatives, to provide comments which identify your issues with disposing of wastes while in the United States. Please submit any of your comments to the contacts listed in the "Address" section of the enclosed Federal Register.


